The Faculty Development Group has selected nationally recognized Dr. Sanford Shugart as its presenter on September 28th at Hilbert College. Under President Shugart's leadership, Valencia College was recently awarded the very first \$600,000 Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence. He is a recognized expert on the subject of student learning-focused and access-focused higher education. Valencia is recognized for its success in preparing students both for the world of work and for further achievement in higher education. Consortium Partnering With NFIEC on Event -Knowledge Economy: Career Paths to a Prosperous WNY

We are expecting K-12 superintendents, school counselors, business leaders, county leaders as well as members from Consortium groups like the Presidents, Chief Academic Officers, Faculty Development Group, and the WNY Association of College Career Centers to be in attendance.

College Law Officers Administrators Group Hosts Training

The WNY College Law Enforcement Administrator Consortium **Group** Sponsored Clery Act Training at Medaille College from August 7th to the 9th. The course was given by Delores Stafford who is a nationally renowned instructor on the Jeanne Clery Act. Approximately 30 personnel attended from both inside and some outside the consortium. This 2-1/2 day workshop was designed to be a comprehensive and intensive Clery Act training class, including all elements of the Clery Act and the new 2008 HEOA security and safety requirements, such as Fire Safety, Emergency Response, Missing Persons, and Additional Hate Crime Reporting requirements. The class covered all the basic requirements and then focused on the advanced elements of the law. The class included a significant amount of training in classifying crimes according to UCR (Federal Uniform Code of Regulations) Guidelines. Also included was a basic overview of the requirements of the Office of Civil Rights and Title IX legislation. Special thanks to Ron Christopher and Medaille College for hosting the event.
